

APPLICATOR Switch Interface

The APPLICATOR Switch Interface regulates the actions of switches and connects them to a device via Bluetooth. It provides Media mode for preconfigured access to play/pause, skip forward and back and Timed Play (10 seconds).

This Bluetooth switch interface is ideal for devices such as an iPad where using a wired switch interface is problematic or for when minimization of cables is desired. Its size makes it ideal for mounting.
