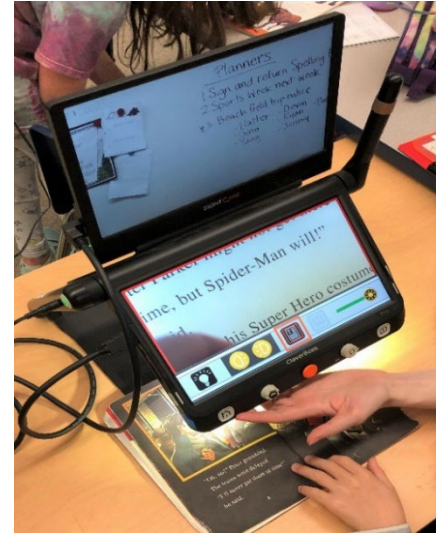


CloverBook Pro

- CloverBook Pro is a foldable, matte touchscreen (12.5") magnifier with OCR functions.
- It is suitable for students looking for a device that is portable, and with options for both tactile and touchscreen access.
- The CloverBook Pro offers the option to have 2 screens for larger split screen viewing – simultaneous views of both cameras.
- It can connect to an additional monitor for larger viewing.
