The Don Johnston Switch Interface allows users to operate a computer using switches.

- Wired, connects to USB ports.
- 5 switch ports (can use any switch).
- Supports 2-switch scanning.
- Indicator lights to show which functions are active. Change functions with push of a button.
- Dimensions 2.5in x 2.5in.
