An E-Tran is a special communication system which enables people to select letters, pictures or symbols with their eyes.

(E-Tran stands for Eye Transfer)

Supports students who...

Have very limited mobility but intentional eye movement to pair with cognition and the ability to choose symbols by eye gaze.
