

# AbleNet Hitch 2 Switch Interface

## Introduction


The Hitch 2 Switch Interface allows users to operate a computer using switches. Key features include:

- Wired, plug-and-play USB connection.
- 5 switch ports (can use any switch).
- A 9-pin D plug for one joystick.
- Supports 2-switch scanning.
- Indicator lights to show which functions are active. Change functions with push of a button.

It supports those with physical, visual, or cognitive challenges of all ages to foster development of switch skills using a computer and switch accessible software.

For macOS Sierra, El Capitan, Yosemite, or Mavericks users, turn on Switch Control for full computer access with one or multiple switches.

Hitch 2 includes a mouse control mode that enables a user to control the on-screen mouse cursor with a joystick or multiple switches.
