

## Micro Light Switch

The Micro Light Switch is:

- A single device that can turn on/off another device
- Wired, single switch
- Activated by light touch pressure
- Auditory click and tactile feedback
- Activation Surface 4.5x1.3cm/1.75x0.5in
- Activating force: 10g/0.4oz
- Travel before activation: 0.7cm/0.25

It supports students who...

- Have limited movement and strength, as the activation requires a 'feather light touch'
