

Reading Supports in the Microsoft Edge Browser

Introduction

The Microsoft Edge browser offers many free, easy to access and easy to use tools to offer reading support. Online text can be read aloud, the text can be enlarged, background colour changed, text masking can be employed and the page can be visually simplified with many distractions removed.

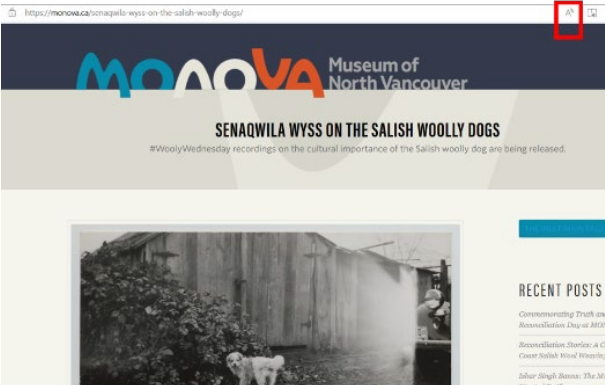
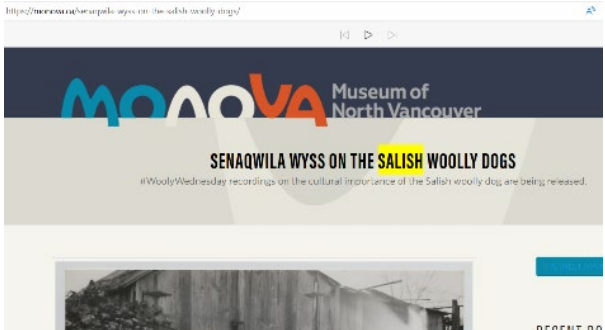
Completing this tutorial will give you experience:

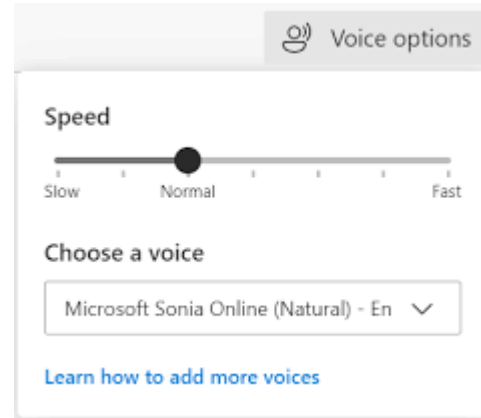
- You have access to the Microsoft Edge browser.

Steps to Follow

Step	Instruction	Visual Depiction
1	<p>Open the Microsoft Edge browser.</p> <p>Navigate to the website you want to work with.</p>	
2	<p>In the address bar, click on the letter A to open the reading supports.</p> <p>The website will begin reading aloud immediately from the top of the page.</p> <p>The play bar at the top allows you to pause, and advance forward and back.</p> <p>Notice that it highlights a line at a time with words underlined as they are spoken.</p> <p>It may be helpful for a student to wear a headset in class so when their writing is read back aloud, it doesn't disturb others.</p>

3	In the top right corner, click on Voice Options to control the reading speed and choose the voice.

4	In the address bar, to the right of Read Aloud, is an icon that looks like an open book. This is Immersive Reader.

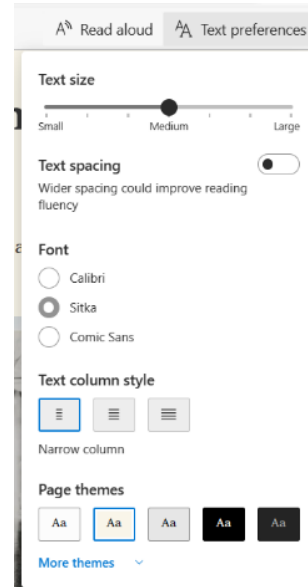
Click on Immersive Reader to open it. Here, the visual distractions are removed, and a tool bar appears in the top right corner.

Read Aloud is the exact same tool described earlier. Operating Read Aloud in Immersive Reader, allows the reader to listen to text read aloud while looking at the webpage with distractions removed.

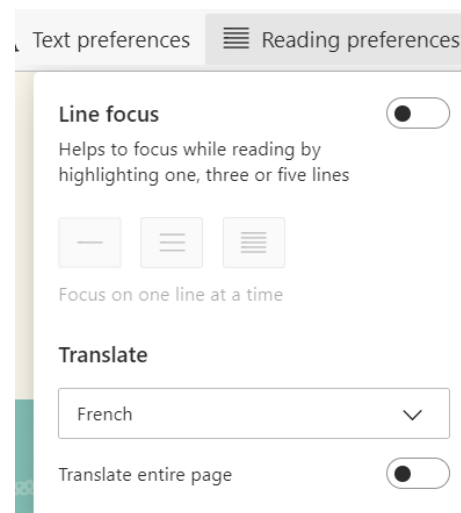

5	<p>Within Text Preferences there are options for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Text size Text Spacing Font Text column style Page themes

6	<p>In Reading Preferences, the user can turn on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Line focus and Translate.

8	<p>In Translate, the user can choose a language and if 'Translate Entire Page' is enabled the text will appear translated into the selected language.</p>
