How to Adapt Display Options for Individual Students

(Options > Display)

Introduction

In this tutorial you will learn how to make and save customizations to the **Display preferences** to personalize learning for individual students and export individual Option preferences.

In Clicker 8, the preferences for each user can be selected and then exported so that a user will have quick access to Clicker 8 tailored to their needs.



This tutorial assumes that you:

- Have Clicker 8 installed on the computer.
- Know how to access **Options** in Clicker 8.

Case Study

Mateo, Sofia, Muhammad, Willow, Maverick, and Isla are in Grade 4. They are using Clicker 8 in the classroom to complete reading and writing assignments. The school-based team is making daily customizations to the **User Options** for each student in Clicker 8. The school-based team would like to export individual **User Options** for each student in the classroom to maximize independence for their reading and writing activities in the classroom.

Adjusting Display Options		
1	<p>Click on Options then Click on the Display icon.</p>	
2	<p>Click on the Colour tab to change the document colour background, text and the cloze blanks. You can also adjust the colour of the background and text in the Clicker sets.</p> <p>Click on ok to save the changes.</p>	
3	<p>Click on the Fonts tab to change the preferences in the document and Clicker sets.</p> <p>Click on ok to save the changes.</p>	

<p>4</p>	<p>Click on the Effects tab to change to the mouseover effects. For example, click on enlarge a cell so that when the pointer is over the cell it will enlarge. Available options to change the cell colour when the pointer is over the cell from light gray, dark gray, inverted or no change.</p> <p>Click on ok to save the changes.</p>	
<p>5</p>	<p>Click on the keyboard tab to change the keyboard layout from Qwerty, Alphabetical or Frequency. There are two choices for the colours of the keyboard from standard to rainbow. You also have the option to show the keyboard when Clicker starts.</p> <p>Click on ok to save the changes.</p>	

6	<p>Click on the Tools tab to change the size of the tools from medium to large. You can also change the contrast of the icons on display to a darker blue. Click on the options you would like to display for the student and click ok.</p>	
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Exporting Student Option Preferences for When More than One Student Is Using the Same Computer

1	<p>From the Options tab, select Export.</p>	
2	<p>You will be prompted to give this User a name. Type the name of the student. Click on where you would like this student Option preferences will be saved and click save.</p> <p>The next time Clicker 8 opens, proceed to the location the student setting preferences was saved and open.</p>

 Create a Class Folder and save the individual student preference settings into this Class Folder.
