- Editing a Learning Grid activity.






- You have an iPad with the Clicker Talk app.

## Case Study

Mrs. Smith has an iPad with the Clicker Talk app and is looking for premade activities to use with her students who can communicate their understanding. Some of her students struggle with the writing process and she allows her students to use digital media to demonstrate their knowledge. She is currently teaching a unit on the life cycle of a butterfly to her grade 2 students.

## Steps to Follow

Step	Instruction	Visual Depiction
1	In the Clicker Talk app, select the explorer icon and navigate to Learning Grids.	
2	A pop up will appear.	
3	To find activities related to the life cycle of a butterfly, type in “butterfly” and select go and you will see a talk set related to the Butterfly Life Cycle.	

Step	Instruction	Visual Depiction
4	Select Open button and you will now see the Clicker Talk activity and have the student complete the activity	
5	Or if you wish to edit the activity, select the pencil icon in the far-right corner and you will be in edit mode.	
6	Select the play button in the far-right corner when finished editing and you will be directed to your new edited talk set.
