

Listen & Say Activities

Introduction

Listen & Say activities enables all learners to familiarize themselves with core vocabulary. Students click on individual pictures on the landing page, listen to the word or phrases and then record their message. The teacher is able to review all their recordings.

- Playing a Listen & Say activity.





This tutorial assumes that:

- Your student is able to record their voice on an iPad.




Case Study

Todd is a grade 2 student and has access to the Clicker Talk app on the classroom iPad. He participates fully in all academic subjects with his peers but has difficulty explaining his knowledge in written format. He is a strong communicator, but writing is often a struggle for him, and he often uses a scribe. His school-based team would like him to become more independent and be able to demonstrate his knowledge using a digital format. His teacher has an iPad with the Clicker Talk app on it and his teacher has given him the opportunity to create a Tell the Story activity about the life cycle of a butterfly.

Steps to Follow

Step	Instruction	Visual Depiction

5	Choose 4 vocabulary words related to the life cycle of a butterfly like caterpillar, eggs, wings, plants, etc. and search for them in the library.	
6	Once all stages are added, select the play icon and the Listen & Say set has been created.	
7	On the landing page, have the student select each vocabulary image and they will hear a short recording. Continue until all images have been heard and select the arrow icon.	
8	A new page will appear with an image of the vocabulary words. Select the record icon at the bottom of the page and students can record their message

9	Select the red circle icon to record a message and select stop when finished. To hear the message again, select the green play button. Select Done when finished.
