

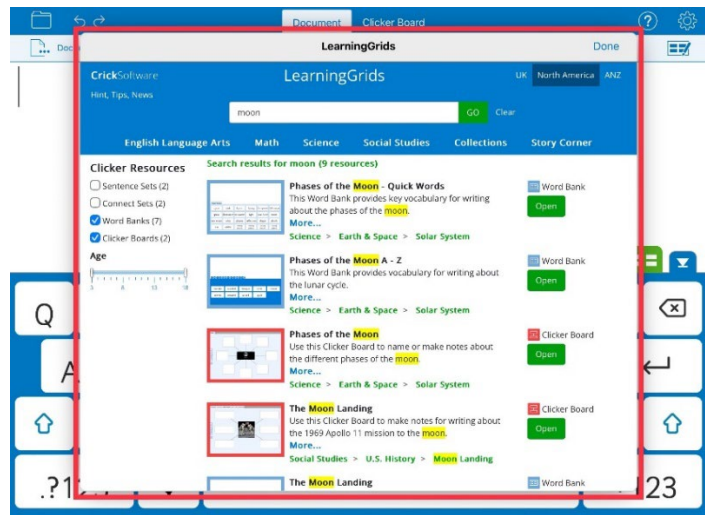
Clicker Writer: Navigating LearningGrids

Task Challenge Activity

1. Launch **Clicker Writer** on your iPad.
2. Tap the **Folder** icon in the top left-hand corner.
3. Tap **LearningGrids**. The **LearningGrids** dialogue box will pop up.
4. Type a search word(s) in the search bar.
5. Try narrowing down your search by clicking which Clicker Resources you want from the menu on the left-hand side.
6. Expand and read the description of the resource of your choice by tapping “**More...**”.
7. Find out which Clicker Set the resource of your choice is (Hint: Find the colour code and the type of Clicker Set next to the description). What colour code is the:
 - a. Sentence Set? – A: green
 - b. Connect Set? – A: yellow
 - c. Word Bank? – A: blue
 - d. Clicker Board? – A: red
8. Open the resource of your choice by tapping the green **Open** button.
