

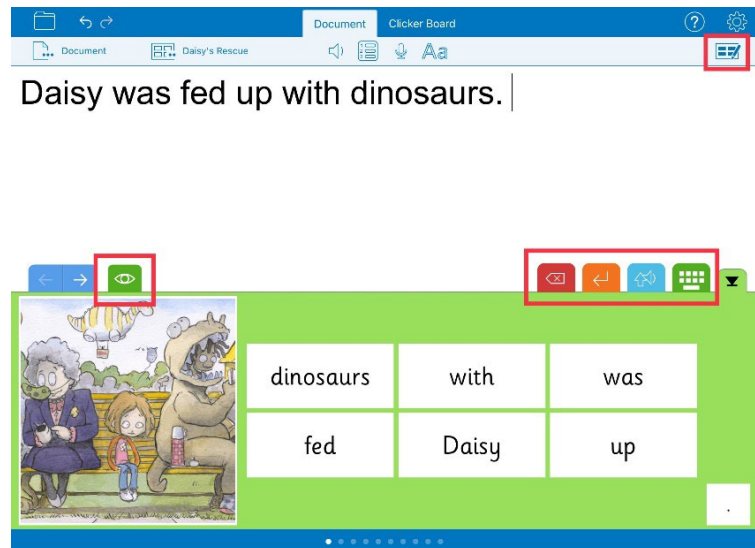
Clicker Writer: Sentence Sets

Introduction

Sentence Sets are great for developing an understanding of sentence structure, proper use of punctuation, building decoding skills, and applying new topic vocabulary.

Task Challenge Activity

1. Launch the **Clicker Writer** app on your iPad and open **LearningGrids** by tapping the **Folder** icon in the top left-hand corner.
2. Tap **LearningGrids** from the menu.
3. From the LearningGrids dialogue box, type a keyword in the search box on top. Try narrowing down your search by filtering age-appropriate Sentence Sets (Hint: check out the left-hand side of the dialogue box) for your students.
4. Open a **Sentence Set**.
5. Explore the coloured buttons/icons in the top right-hand corner of the Sentence Set.
 - a. What does the **red** button do?
 - b. What does the **orange** button do?
 - c. What does the **blue** button do?
 - d. What does the **green** button do?
6. Find where the model sentence is located.

7. Explore how to edit the Sentence Set (Hint: top right-hand corner). Go to the edit mode.
 - a. Try adding at least one more sentence to the Sentence Set.
 - b. Explore how the model sentence changes when you tap under **MODEL**:
 - i. None
 - ii. View & Copy
 - iii. View & Remember
 - iv. Listen
 - c. Explore how the order of the cells change on each grid under **ORDER**:
 - i. Alphabetical
 - ii. Random
 - iii. Sentence Order
 - iv. Guided Order
 - v. What is the difference between Sentence Order and Guided Order?
 - d. Explore how the layout of the grid changes when you toggle on/off under **LAYOUT**:
 - i. Hide Duplicates
 - ii. Sentence Picture
 - iii. Maximize Cell Height
 - e. Where can you see the preview of any changes you have made?
 - i. What happens when you tap each cell on the grid?
 - ii. How do you change the picture?
 - iii. How do you add a picture to a cell?
 - iv. How do you change the background colour of the grid?
 - f. What do you need to do if you want to apply the same settings to all grids of the Sentence Set?
 - g. How do you go back to the Document with the Sentence Set? (Hint: Go>)
8. Flip the grids/pages on the Sentence Set. (Hint: blue arrows)
9. Save the changes. (Hint: Tap the **Clicker Set** icon in the top left-hand corner next to the **Document** icon)
10. How do you create a Sentence Set from scratch? (Hint: Tap the **Clicker Set** icon > New Clicker Set > Sentence Set)
