

Clicker Writer – Creating a Word Bank

Case Study

Lucy is a grade 5 student who needs support with her writing. She requires word prediction to be able to write about various topics. Her teacher wants to create a word bank on the Clicker Writer app so she can use the appropriate subject-specific vocabulary in her writing.

How to Create a Word Bank	
<p>1</p>	<p>Once you have opened the Clicker Writer app, click on the grid icon to start creating a new word bank.</p> 
<p>2</p>	<p>Click on New Clicker Set.</p> 
<p>3</p>	<p>Click on the blue Word Bank icon.</p> 
<p>4</p>	<p>Click on Word Bank Name and rename and press Create.</p> 

<p>5</p>	<p>Click on the + icon and Add Multiple Grids.</p>	
<p>6</p>	<p>Choose whether to sort the words into Topic Grids or Alphabetical Grids.</p>	
<p>7</p>	<p>Type or paste text into the text box to make up your Word Bank and choose whether to filter out most common English words.</p>	
<p>8</p>	<p>Click Create Grids to create your Word Bank.</p>	

<p>9</p>	<p>Click the Order drop-down box to change how the words are displayed.</p>	
<p>10</p>	<p>Click on the colour palette to change the colour of the grid.</p>	
<p>11</p>	<p>Click Go to use the Word Bank.</p>	

Tip...

Find saved word banks in your files on your iPad by clicking on the file folder on the top left-hand side of the screen. Choose **My Files** and search for Clicker writer folder.
