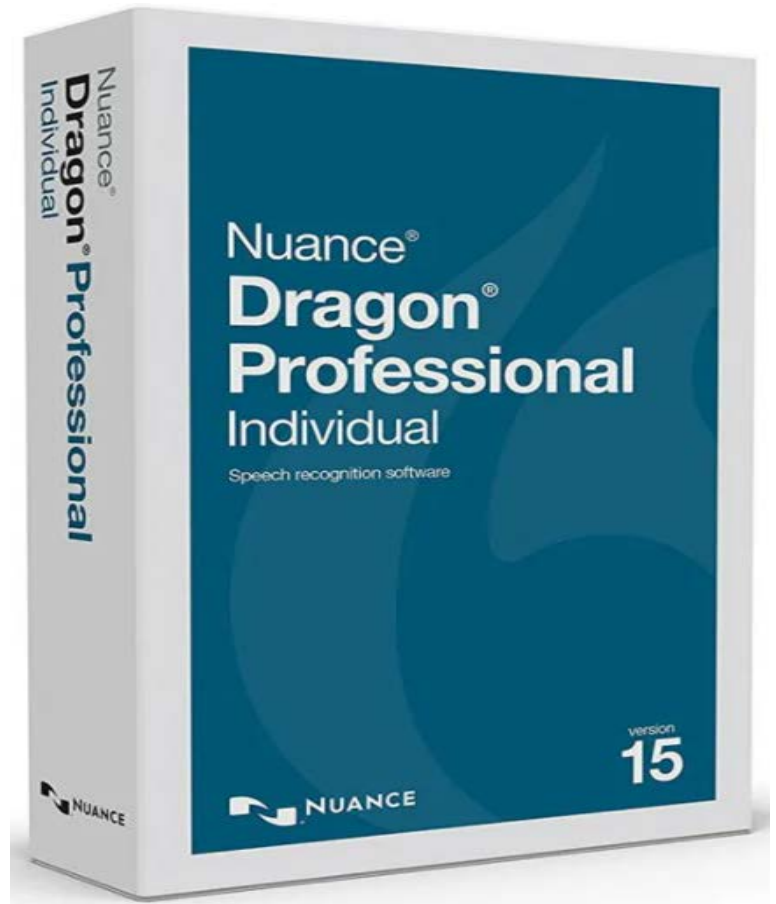


How to Customize Dragon Vocabulary
