

# Pictello: Features and Implementation Strategies

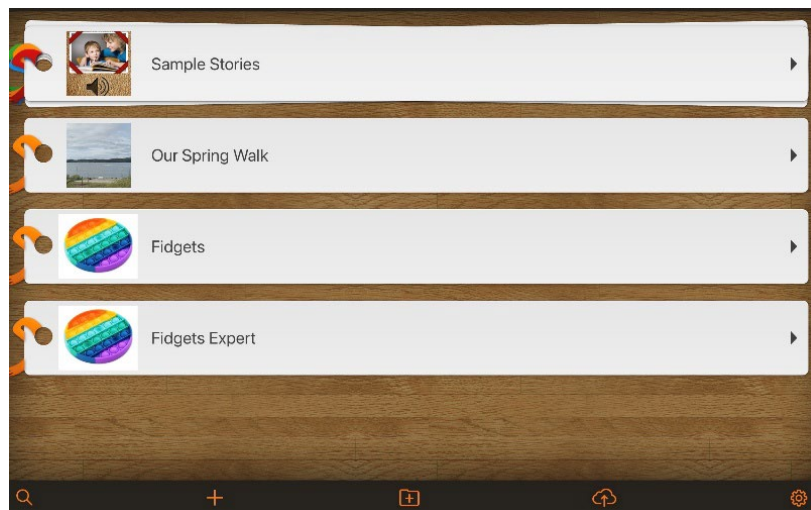


## Introduction

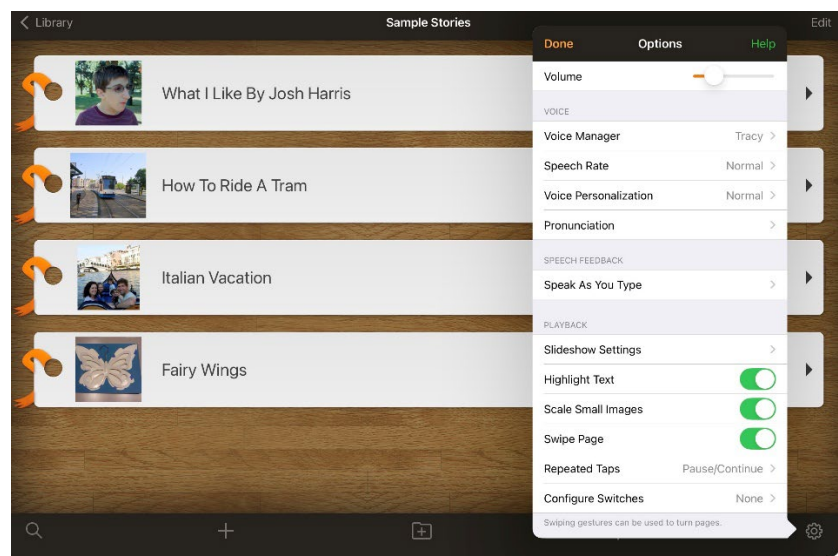
## Features:

- backup within app



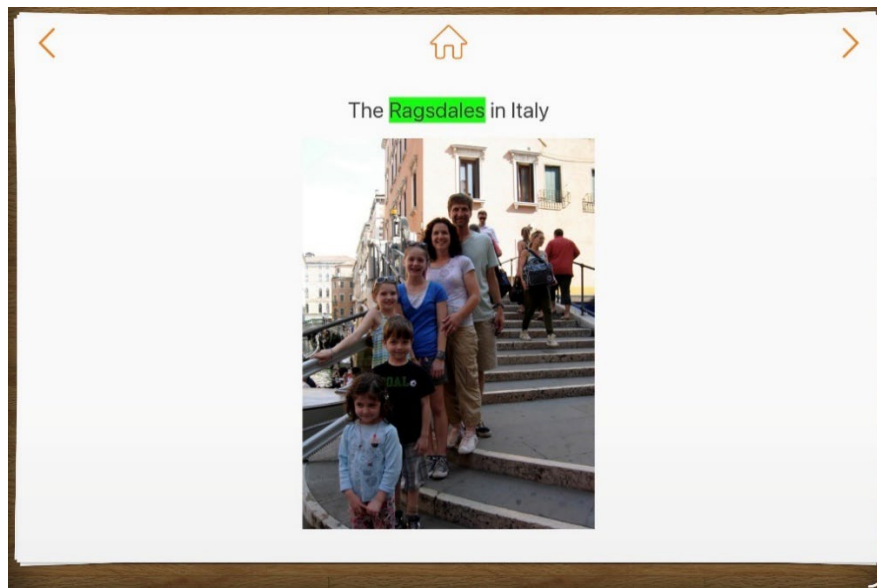
## Options for Customizations:
