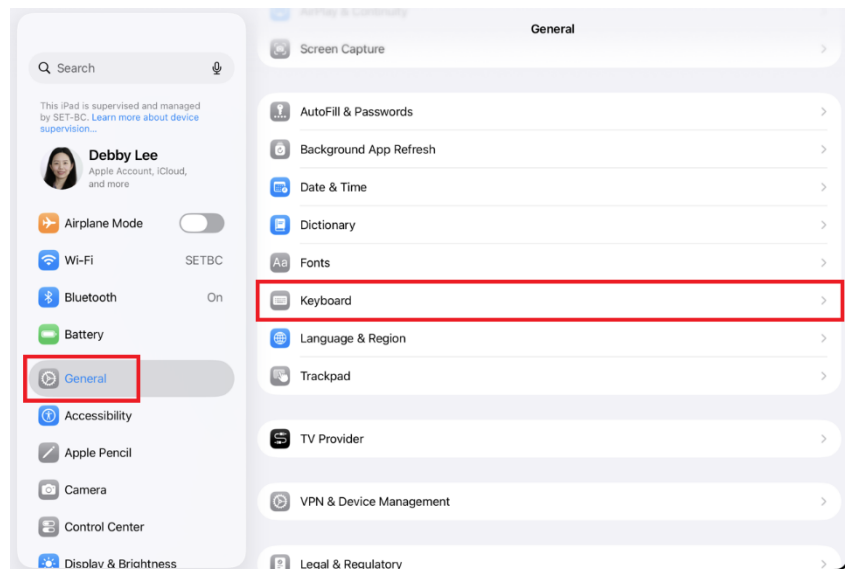
Introduction

Predictive Text on the iPad suggests words or phrases as you type to support faster and more efficient writing. The following steps outline how to access and enable Predictive Text on an iPad.

Steps to Follow

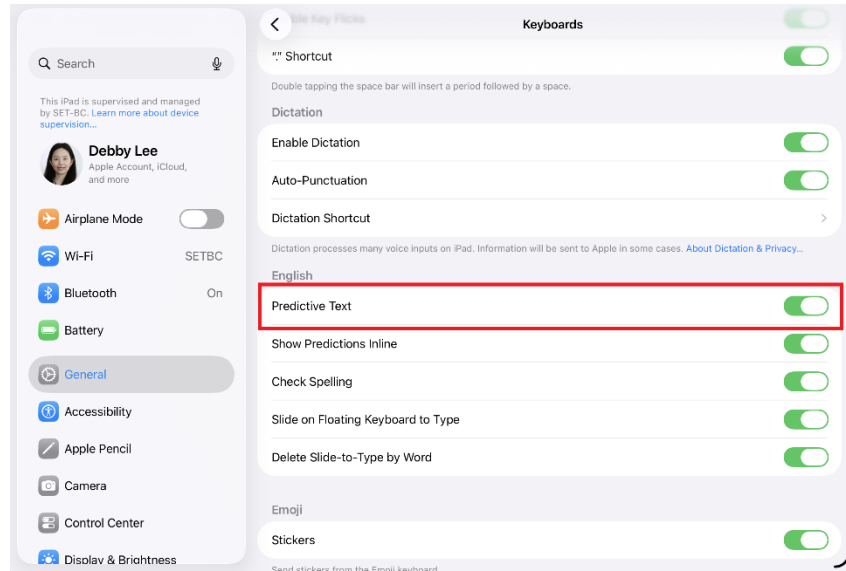

1	On your iPad, go to Settings > General > Keyboard .

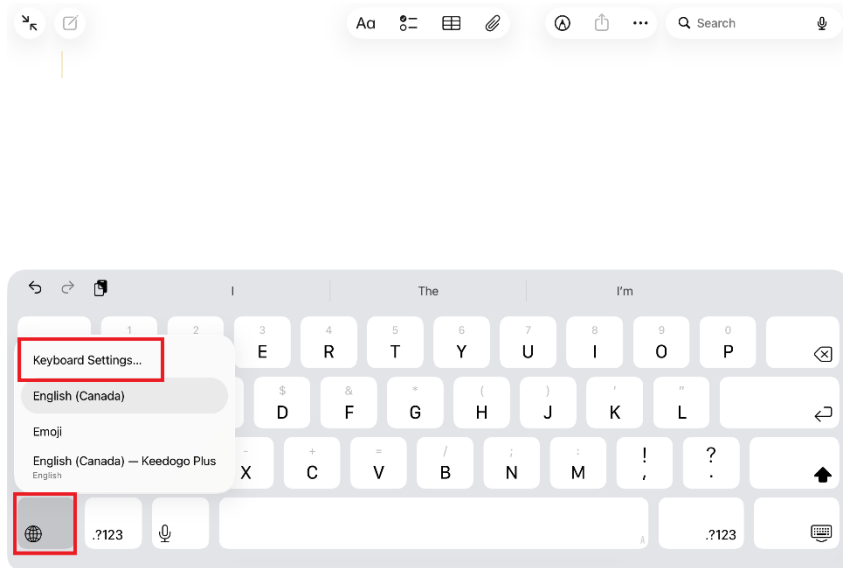
2 Scroll down to the **English** section.
Toggle on **Predictive Text**.



3 You can also turn on Predictive Text from the onscreen keyboard.

On the keyboard, touch and hold the emoji (smiley face) or Globe icon, then tap **Keyboard Settings**.

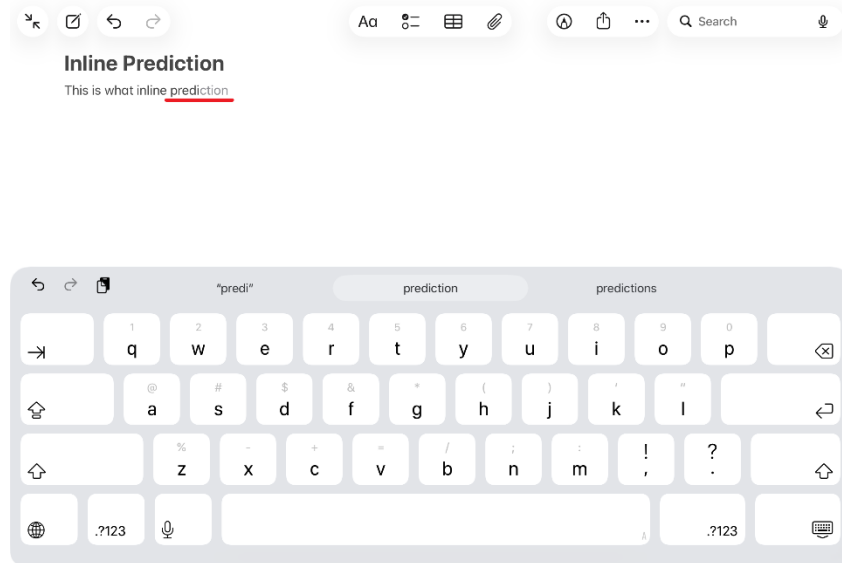
This will open the Keyboard Settings on the iPad. Turn on **Predictive Text** to enable it.



Step Instruction Visual Depiction

4 When **“Show Predictions Inline”** is enabled, suggested word completions appear in gray text as you type.

Tap the **Space bar** to accept the suggestion or continue typing to ignore it.



5 You can also set up custom shortcuts (e.g., typing “OMW” to expand to “On my way!”).

To do this, go to **Settings > General > Keyboard > Text Replacement.**
