

# Screen Masking for Read&Write on Google Chrome

### Introduction

Screen masking is a feature of the Read&Write Google chrome extension and can be used as a document reading tool to eliminate any distractions and allow for better focus.

## Using the Screen Masking Tool

1	Start by opening a website on Google Chrome that you will focus on	
2	To enable Screen masking, <b>Open</b> the Read&Write extension and the extension tool bar will now appear on the website.	
3	Select the screen masking feature on the extension toolbar

5	To change features like size of the strip, opacity, or background colour, select the settings (gear) icon or the more () and then options

6 From here, you can change opacity, reading light, background colour and height of the strip. Select OK when done.
