

Read&Write for Google Chrome – Simplify Page

Introduction

Simplify Page is a tool that is available as part of Read&Write for Google Chrome. It offers the user the ability to reduce the complexity of a reading passage. There are many tools that achieve this but the outcome is often different depending on the algorithms that are employed by the tool. Some tools reduce the quantity of sentences, while others make the passage smaller and easier to read, or increasing contrast for those who need visual support, while maintaining the context.

Learning Objectives

Completion of this tutorial will give you experience with the following:

- Distill a web page using Read&Write for Chrome
- Decrease or Increase the length of the passage depending on the ability of the reader
- Change the contrast color

- Access to Google Chrome browser on a Windows, Mac or Chromebook computer and NOT a tablet.

Case Study

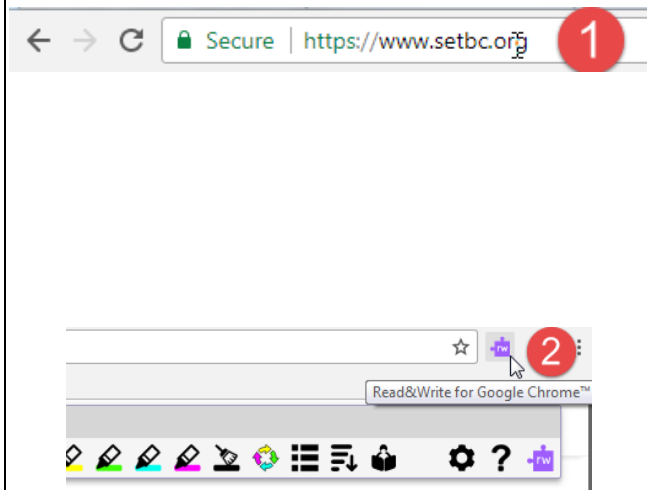
Web Search using Read&Write for Google Chrome

Open a web page in your Chrome Browser. (1)

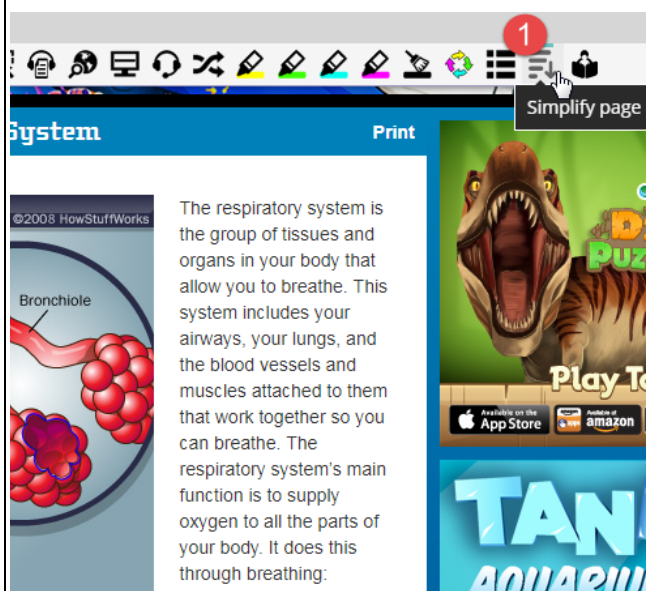
Ensure that the Read&Write Chrome extension is running by locating the purple R&W icon will appear in the top right hand corner.

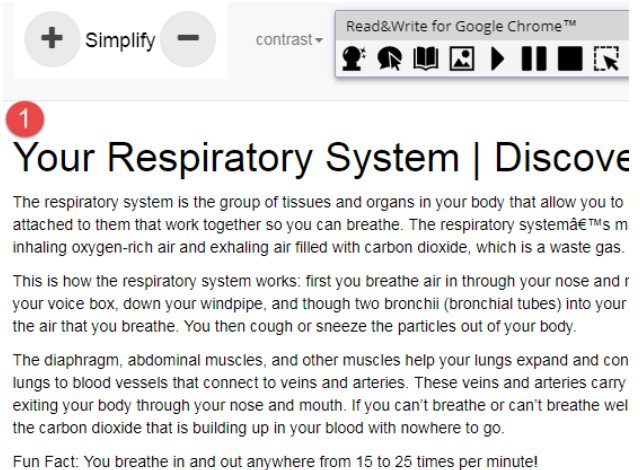
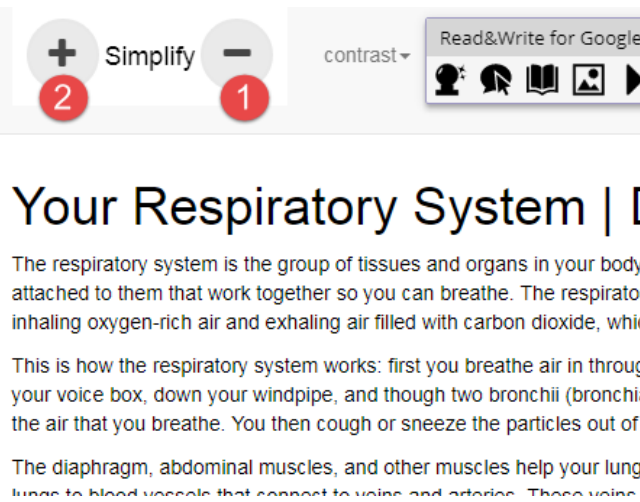
Click on the icon (2) to activate the Read&Write toolbar.

Click the *Simplify Page* tool icon in the tool bar (1).

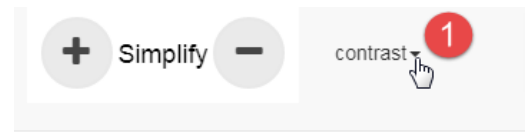

Click on the *contrast* drop-down menu (1).

Click on any of the contrast options to adjust the background color and text color (2).



Your Respiratory System
