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# Comprehensive Literacy for All

Comprehensive Literacy for all is an evidence-based methodology for teaching students with significant disabilities to read and write. (<u>Karen Erickson and David</u> <u>Koppenhave</u>r)

It follows some basic tenets that include:

All children can learn to read and write. Progress begins when learning opportunity begins.

Emergent literacy is highly dependent upon the nature, frequency, accessibility and interpretability of experiences with print.

The aim of the books/activities in this collection is to provide meaningful experiences with accessible print that fit into a systematic approach to teaching emergent literacy.

# **Comprehensive** <u>**Emergent</u> Literacy - Shared Reading**</u>

The goal of Shared Reading is to increase student engagement and interaction during a shared reading experience.

Student-oriented responses require following the student's lead and providing sufficient wait time for contributions.

Use open-ended questions or comments and monitor student engagement and participation, rather than asking for a correct response.


