- reads aloud text on a page
- breaks words into syllables
- able to increase spacing between lines and letters
- improve reading comprehension and fluency
- works with OneNote, Word, Edge

Select to Speak (Android 9.0 and higher)

- reads aloud selected text
- hear descriptions of things on your screen
- use camera and have pictures or text described to you with OCR (Optical Character Recognition)
- able to multi-task while reading

- reads text on screen in its entirety
- able to increase/decrease speed of speech
- can use while multitasking to read an article or ebook
- can use **Speak Selection** to read aloud selected text
- used well with Safari Reader View (declutters webpages)
