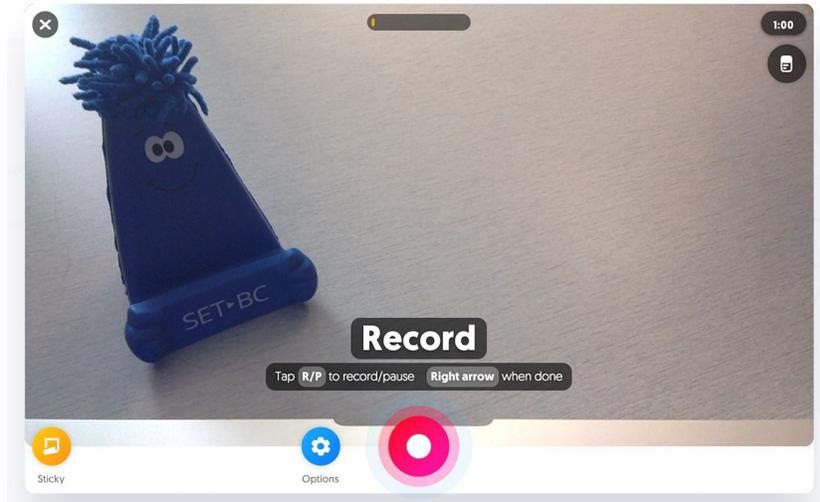
Introduction

Flipgrid is video discussion platform that allows teachers to post a discussion prompt or question, and for students to respond and interact through short videos. Flipgrid is available for use as a web-based tool, or can be downloaded as an iOS or Android app.

Task Challenge Activity

Create a Grid:

- On your computer, visit www.flipgrid.com
- Register for a free Flipgrid account, or login to your account
- Create a new grid by clicking “Add New Grid”
- Customize your grid by giving it a name and selecting a grid type.
- Click “next” to create the grid.
- Within your grid create a topic where students will post by clicking “new topic”
- Enter your topic details and click “Create Topic.”

Post to a Topic:

- Access Flipgrid online, by opening the app, or scanning the QR code
- Enter the Flipcode and/or password provided (if prompted)
- Click the green circle with the addition symbol
- Login if prompted to do so
- Allow camera & microphone access
- Create your video in response to the prompt, or upload a video
- Click “next” to edit your recording, add a title, and notes, or re-record using the icons at the bottom of the recording screen
- Post your response with a cover image by clicking “next” and snapping a selfie. Customize your cover image by clicking the happy face icon.

Respond to Posts:

- Double click on the post and click the green reply icon.
