

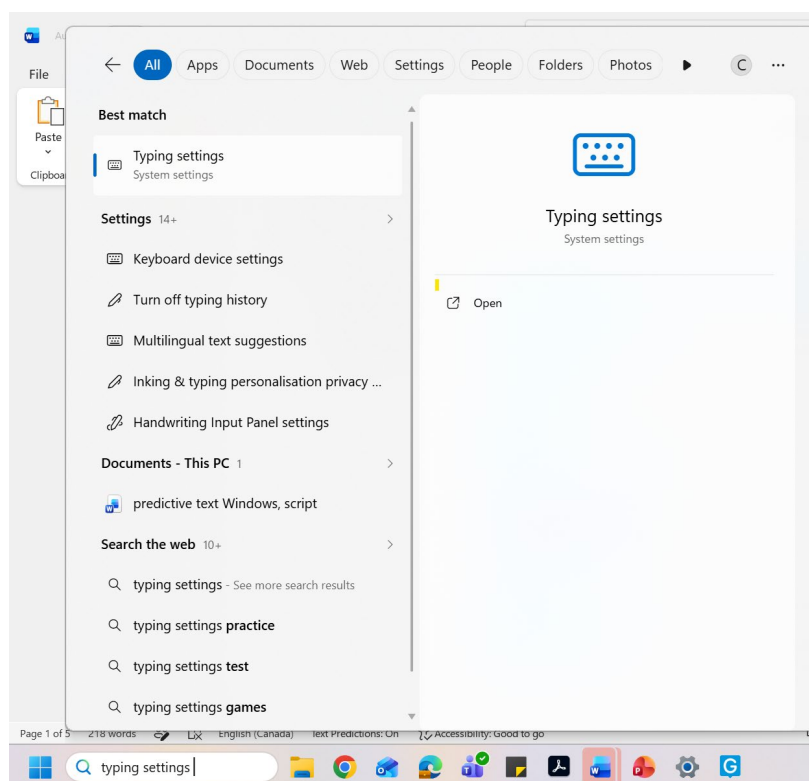
# Predictive Text (Windows)

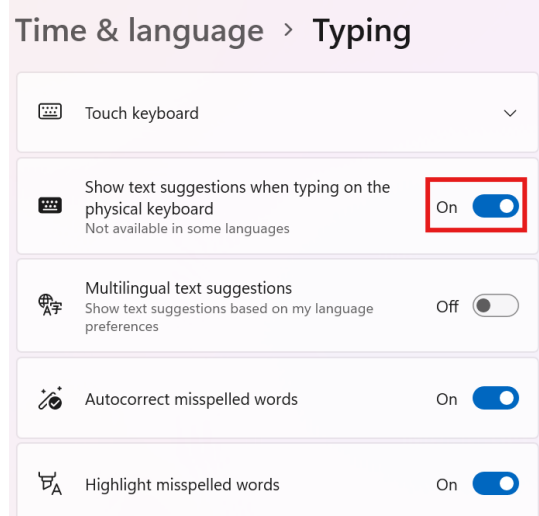
| Step | Instruction | Visual Depiction |

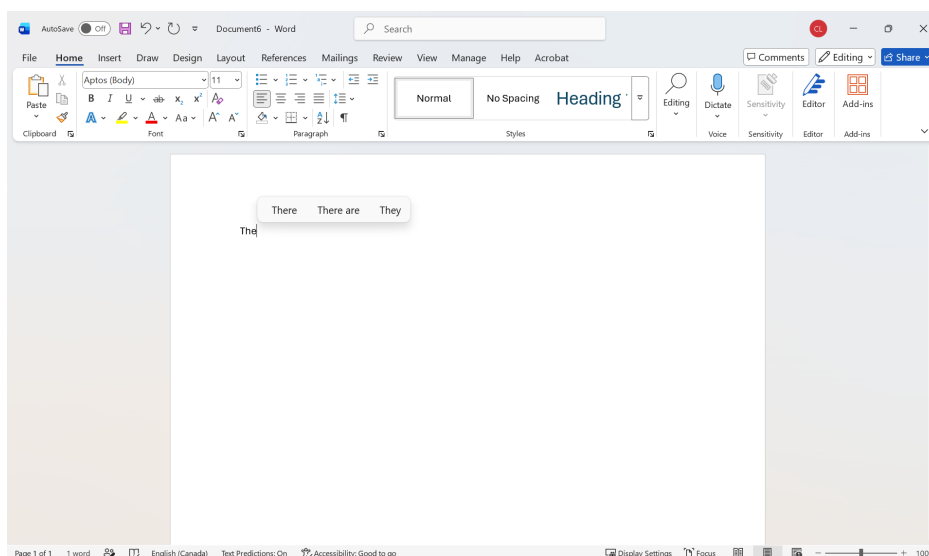


| Step | Instruction | Visual Depiction |
