

- that you have at a minimum, iOS14 installed on your device.

Case Study

John has a visual impairment and needs the text on his iPad screen enlarged. At times, he also benefits from having the screen displayed in contrasting colours or having different filters applied.

Using the Display & Text Size tool

| 1 | To enable Display & Text Size, Open the Settings app by tapping the icon. |  |
| 2 | Go to Accessibility and click on Display & Text Size |  |
| 3 | Toggle on the following: Bold Text Larger Text Button Shapes On/Off Labels Reduce Transparency |  |
| 4 | Toggle increase contrast to increase colour between an app foreground and background colour. |  |
| 5 | Toggle smart invert and classic invert to reverse the colour of display. |  |
