Magnifier allows users to turn the iPad into a magnifying glass and be able to zoom in on objects near you.



This tutorial assumes

- An iPad with iOS 14 or later version.
- Activities below assume an internet connection; however, it is not necessary to enable or use the feature.

Case Study:

Maddy is a grade 6 student who has a visual impairment and has difficulty with seeing the text on the classroom's whiteboard. She has access to an iPad and can use the magnifier feature to zoom onto the notes that her teacher is writing on the board without having to move her seat.

<p>1</p>	<p>From the iPad’s Home Screen, find and tap on the Settings icon to access the Settings Menu.</p>	
<p>2</p>	<p>On the left scroll down menu, locate and tap Accessibility.</p>	
<p>3</p>	<p>On the right side, tap Magnifier.</p>	
<p>4</p>	<p>Toggle Magnifier on and a new app will appear on the Ipad screen.</p>	

<p>5</p>	<p>Focus on an object in the room and use the slider to zoom in and out.</p>	
<p>6</p>	<p>You can also adjust the contrast, brightness or filter in the Magnifier app.</p>	
<p>7</p>	<p>To freeze the image, tap on the circle icon.</p>
