

# Per-App Settings, iOS 15



## Case Study:

Jane has a visual impairment and has a school iPad that she shares with her classmates. There is an app that she often uses. Using Per-App Settings, she can customize display and text size settings – e.g. bold or enlarge text, increase contrast, invert colours, add colour filters, etc. – for only the app she wants.

## This tutorial assumes that:

- you have an iOS device with version 15 software.
- you have an app in mind on your iOS device that you want to customize.

# How to Use Per-App Settings

<p><b>1</b></p>	<p>Go to <b>Settings &gt; Accessibility</b>.</p>	
<p><b>2</b></p>	<p>Swipe down and tap <b>Per-App Settings</b>.</p>	
<p><b>3</b></p>	<p>Tap <b>Add App</b>.</p>	


**4** Choose the app you want to customize from the list.

You can also customize **Home Screen** and **Settings** of your iOS device.

For this tutorial, I have chosen the **Book Creator** app.




**5** Tap the **app** you just added.





Choose a setting and select **On** or **Off**.



- **Bold Text:** Make the text bold within the app.
- **Larger Text:** Adjust the text size within the app.
- **Button Shapes:** Buttons within the app will be underlined when turned on.
- **On/Off Labels:** On/Off toggles within the app will be labeled when turned on.
- **Reduce Transparency:** It will be blurred on some backgrounds to increase legibility and improve contrast when turned on.
- **Increase Contrast:** When turned on, it will increase colour contrast between app foreground and background colours.
- **Differentiate Without Color:** Turning this on will replace user interface items that rely solely on colour to convey information with alternatives.
- **Smart Invert:** Turning this on will reverse the colours of the display, except for images, media and some apps that use dark colour styles.
- **Reduce Motion:** Turning this on will reduce the motion of the user interface, including the parallax effect of icons – e.g. animation effects.
- **Auto-Play Video Previews:** Turning this on will allow video previews to automatically start playing when they are available.

# How to Remove Per-App Settings

<p><b>1</b></p>	<p>Go to <b>Settings &gt; Accessibility</b>.</p>	
<p><b>2</b></p>	<p>Swipe down and tap <b>Per-App Settings</b>.</p>

Swipe left on the **app name** and tap the red **Delete** button.

To set the default values for any one of the settings within the app, tap **the app name** and then tap the individual setting and choose **Default**.
